On December 16, 2011, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition, pursuant to Article 37, paragraph 2 of the Law on Protection of Competition ("Official Journal of the RS", no. 51/09) and Article 2, paragraph 1, item 6, of Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competency of Commission for Protection of Competition ("Official Journal of the RS", no. 47/2011) deciding under notification of concentration no. 6/0-02-906/2011-1, submitted by Company for production and trade "Meat Industry Matijevic" d.o.o., from Novi Sad, with registered head-office at Rumenicki put 86, through its legal representative – manager of the company, Mr. Milan Jozanov, issued a following

### Decision

I Concentration of market participants is approved in summary procedure created by acquisition, on the part of company for production and trade "Meat

Industry Matijevic" d.o.o. from Novi Sad with registered head-office at Rumenicki put 86, reference number 08588759, of entire movable and immovable capital of company in bankruptcy, shareholding company for farm and cattle products and agricultural services "Tromedja", with registered head-office at Marsala Tita 2, from Majdan, making a functional entirety.

II It is established that company "Meat Industry Matijevic" d.o.o., as applicant of relevant concentration effected payment, in prescribed period, of 2.564.466,81 dinars to the account of Commission for Protection of Competition no. 840-000000880668-16, maintained with Treasury within the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Serbia, reference number 6/0-02-906/2011-1, representing corresponding level of compensation in dinar countervalue at the date of payment,

for issuance of decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure, referred to in Article 2, paragraph 1, item 6 of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competency of Commission for Protection of Competition.
