On November 11, 2011, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition, pursuant to Article 37, paragraph 2 of the Law on Protection of Competition ("Official Journal of the RS", no. 51/09) and Article 2, paragraph 1, item 6, of Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competency of Commission for Protection of Competition ("Official Journal of the RS", no. 47/2011) deciding under notification of concentration no. 6/0-02-833/2011-1 submitted, on behalf of client – Greek business enterprise Alpha Bank A.E. Athens, with head-office at Stadiou 40, 10252 Athens, Republic of Greece, entered into Greek Ministry of Economy, Competition Protection and Maritime Navy, under reference no. 6066/06/B/86/05 - against power of attorney, by lawyers from Beograd Ms. Mira Todorovic, Ustanicka 136 and Ms. Jasmina Kuzenko-Taskovic, Tadeusa Koscuska 30, issued a following

Decision

I Concentration of market participants is approved in summary procedure created as a result of changes to the status due to the merger by acquisition, by way of Greek business enterprise Alpha Bank S.A., Athens, with head-office at Stadiou 40, 10252 Athens, Republic of Greece, reference number 6066/06/B/86/05, on the grounds of changes to the status due to merger, acquiring Greek business enterprise EFG Eurobank Ergasias S.A., with head-office at Othonos 8, 10557 Athens, Republic of Greece, entered under reference number 6068/06/B/86/07, whereby acquired company ceases to exist, and the bank created by merger shall operate under the new corporative name – Alpha Eurobank S.A.

II It is established that the parties involved in notified concentration, effected payment, in prescribed period, of EUR 25.000,00 to the foreign currency account of Commission for Protection of Competition maintained with National Bank of Serbia, reference no. 6/0-02-833/2011-1 in such manner that the amount of 12.500,00 EUR was paid by applicant of concentration – company Alpha Bank

A.E. Athens, whereas company to be acquired by applicant of concentration – EFG Eurobank Ergasias paid the amount of 12.500,00 EUR, thus jointly making corresponding level of compensation for issuance of decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure referred to in Article 2, paragraph 1, item 6 of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competency of Commission for Protection of Competition.
