On August 31, 2012, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition, pursuant to Article 37, paragraph 2 of the Law on Protection of Competition ("Official Journal of the RS", no. 51/09) and Article 2, paragraph 1, item 6, of Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competency of Commission for Protection of Competition ("Official Journal of the RS", no. 47/2011), deciding under notification of concentration no. 6/0-02-597/2012-1, dated August 14, 2012, submitted on behalf of client-company Chicago Bridge & Iron Company N.V. with its corporative head-office at Oostduinlaan 75, 2596 JJ 's-Gravenhage, the Hague, Netherlands, under power of attorney by lawyer Ms. Marina Bulatovic from law office Wolf Theiss, PC Usce, Bulevar Mihajla Pupina 6, 11 070 Novi Beograd, issued a following

DECISION

I Concentration of market participants is approved in summary procedure created by acquisition of sole control on the part of company Chicago Bridge & Iron Company N.V., limited liability company, with head-office at Oostduinlaan 75, 2596 JJ 's-Gravenhage, the Hague, Netherlands, by virtue of its subsidiary company - corporation Crystal Acquisition Subsidiary Inc., from Louisiana, with head-office at 546 Carondelet Street, New Orleans, LA 70130, Louisiana, U.S.A., over company The Shaw Group Inc., from Louisiana, with head-office at 4171 Essen Lane, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70809, U.S.A.

II It is established that the applicant in relevant concentration effected payment, in prescribed period, of 25.000 EUR to the foreign currency account of the Commission for Protection of Competition maintained with National Bank of Serbia, reference no. 6/0-02-597/2012-1, representing corresponding level of compensation for issuance of decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure, referred to in Article 2, paragraph 1, item 6 of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competency of Commission for Protection of Competition.
