On July 2, 2012 President of the Commission for Protection of Competition pursuant to Article 37, paragraph 2 of the Law on Protection of Competition ("Official Journal of the RS", no. 51/09) and Article 2, paragraph 1, item 6, of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competency of Commission for Protection of Competition ("Official Journal of the RS", no. 47/2011) deciding under notification of concentration entered under no. 6/0-02-428/2012-1, submitted against enclosed power of attorney for representation by lawyers Ms. Darija Ognjenovic and Ms. Marijanti Babic from Beograd, from law-office Prica and Partners, located at Kralja Petra 13, 11000 Beograd on behalf of their client – company JT International Holding B.V., with registered head-office at Vreelandseweg 46, 1216 CH Hilversum, Kingdom of Netherlands, company reference no. 32073749, issued a following

DECISION

I Concentration of market participants is approved in summary procedure created by acquisition of control on the part of company JT International Holding B.V., company reference no. 32073749, with head-office at Vreelandseweg 46, 1216 CH Hilversum, Kingdom of Netherlands, over company V.D.M. Invest Comm. V.A. with head-office at Bosstraat 10, 8570 Vichte, Belgium, company reference no. 0469.4110.407, as a result of implementation of Agreement on Purchase of Shares, whereby party acquiring control over company V.D.M. Invest Comm. V.A. shall buy 99,99% of shares of target company from current owner of those shares – Belgium company GT & Co., by which, as a result of such transaction and its closure, buyer directly or indirectly acquires 100% of share capital in company V.D.M. Invest Comm. V.A., 100% shares in company Gryson NV, 100% shares in company Dispotrab S.L. and 50% shares in company Gryson Deutschland GmbH.

II It is established that applicant in relevant concentration effected payment, in prescribed period, of EUR 25.000, by paying, on June 8, 2012, the amount of EUR 24.976,50 to foreign currency account of the Commission for Protection of Competition maintained with National Bank of Serbia, whereas the difference upto prescribed level in the amount of RSD 2.693,10 was paid on June 26, 2012 to the dinar account of the Commission for Protection of Competition no. 840-0000000880668-16 maintained with Treasury within the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Serbia, representing in total, corresponding level of compensation for issuance of decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure referred to in Article 2, paragraph 1, item 6, of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competency of the Commission for Protection of Competition.
