Pursuant to Article 37(2) of the Law on Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, nos. 51/09 and 95/13), Article 192(1) of the Law on General Administrative Procedure (“Official Gazette of the FRY”, nos. 33/97, 31/01 and “Official Gazette of the RS”, no. 30/10), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensation for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, no. 49/11), deciding under the notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-597/2016-1, submitted on August 17, 2016, by company „ZF Friedrichshafen“ JSC, with registered seat at the address Graf-von-Soden-Platz 1, 88046 Friedrichshafen, Germany, via plenipotentiary attorney Srđana Petronijević from the Law office “Moravčević, Vojnović and Partners”, with registered seat at the address 15 Dobračina Street, Belgrade, on September 9, 2016, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by establishing joint control on the part of company „ZF Friedrichshafen“ JSC, with registered seat at the address Graf-von-Soden-Platz 1, 88046 Friedrichshafen, Germany, company registration number HRB 630206, and natural person Konrad Crafft, with registered residence at Fildenstrasse 17, 88048 Friedrichshafen, Germany, over company „DoubleSlash Net-Business“ LLC, with registered seat at the address Otto-Lilienthal-Str.2, 88046 Friedrichshafen, Germany, company registration number HRB 631718, by acquiring 40 % of shares in company „DoubleSlash Net-Business by „ZF Friedrichshafen“ company from its previous sole member, natural person Konrad Crafft who keeps 60% of shares.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the applicant of notification has executed payment in the amount of RSD 3,081,345.00 (in words: three million, eighty-one thousand, three hundred forty-five Dinars) to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition maintained with the Treasury Administration of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Serbia, which represents determined amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
