Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, nos. 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, no. 49/11), deciding under the notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-447/2017-1 of June 15, 2017, submitted by company “Robert Bosch” GmbH, with registered seat at the address Robert-Bosch-Platz 1, 70839 Gerlingen-Schillerhöhe, Germany, represented by plenipotentiary attorney Srdana Petronijević from the Law office “Moravčević, Vojnović & Partneri” from Belgrade, 15 Dobračina St., on July 7, 2017, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of indirect control on the part of company “Robert Bosch” GmbH, with registered seat at the address Robert-Bosch-Platz 1, 70839 Gerlingen-Schillerhöhe, Germany, company registration number HRB 14000, via its wholly owned subsidiary and direct acquirer of control, company „Robert Bosch“ Ltda, with registered seat at the address Anhanguera S/N, KP 98, Vila Boa Vista, Campinas, Sao Paulo, Brazil, company registration number 45.990.181/0001-89, over target business operations encompassing gasoline fuel pump inputs of company „Associated Fuel Pump Systems Corporation“, with registered seat at the address 1100 Scotts Bridge Rd., Anderson, SC 29621, United States of America.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the applicant of notification has executed payment in the amount of RSD 3,038,775.00 (in words: three million, thirty-eight thousand, seven hundred seventy-five dinars) on June 27, 2017 to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents determined amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
