Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-624/2017-1 of September 29, 2017, submitted by company Societe Generale Banka Srbija a.d. Beograd, with registered seat at the address 50 a/b Zorana Đinđića Boulevard, Belgrade, company registration number 07552335, via attorney at law Bojana Miljanović from the Law Office of Karanović & Nikolić from Belgrade, 23 Resavska St., on October 13, 2017, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of control on the part of company Societe Generale Banka Srbija a.d. Beograd, with registered seat at the address 50 a/b Zorana Đinđića Boulevard, Belgrade, company registration number 07552335, over a part of business operations of company Jubanka a.d. Beograd, with registered seat at the address 11 Kralja Milana St., Belgrade, company registration number 07736681, by acquiring a part of credit portfolio.

**II IT IS ESTABLISHED** that the applicant of notification, company Societe Generale Banka Srbija a.d. Beograd, with registered seat at the address 50 a/b Zorana Đinđića Boulevard, Belgrade, has executed payment in the amount of RSD 2,979,425.00 (in words: two million, nine hundred seventy-nine thousand, four hundred twenty-five and 00/100 dinars) on October 3, 2017, to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents determined amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
