Pursuant to Article 37(2) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13) and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/2011), deciding under the Notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-370/2015-1 of April 30, 2015, submitted by company Nokia Corporation from Finland, via attorney at law Bojana Miljanović from the Law Office of Karanović & Nikolić from Belgrade, 23 Resavska St., on June 10, 2015, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of control on the part of company Nokia Corporation, with registered seat at the address Karaportti 3, FI-02610 Espoo, Uusimaa, Finland, registered in the Trade Register in Helsinki under company registration number 0112038-9, over company Alcatel-Lucent, with registered seat at the address 148/152 Route de la Reine 92100 Boulogne-Billancourt, France, registered in the Trade and Companies Register maintained in the Commercial Court in Nanterre under company registration number 542 019 096, created by acquisition of all of the published ordinary shares of company Alcatel-Lucent from its owners – shareholders of Alcatel-Lucent, via public exchange offer published in France and the United States of America, for newly issued Nokia shares in accordance with the determined exchange ratio.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the applicant of notification on concentration has executed payment of the fee as compensation for issuing decision of the Commission on approval of concentration in summary procedure in the amount of EUR 25,000.00 (in words: twenty-five thousand euro) to the foreign-currency account of the Commission for Protection of Competition maintained with the National Bank of Serbia, which is in accordance with the regulated fee from Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition.
