Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/2011), deciding under the notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-678/2017-1, submitted by company Benu d.o.o. Beograd, with registered seat in Belgrade at the address 239 Kumodraška St., represented by Srđana Petronijević, attorney at law from the Law Office „Moravčević, Vojnović & Partneri“ from Belgrade, 15 Dobračina St., on December 27, 2017, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of individual direct control on the part of company Benu d.o.o. Beograd, with registered seat in Belgrade at the address 239 Kumodraška St., company number 20373792, over company Inter Pharma d.o.o. Subotica, with registered seat in Subotica at the address 14 Matije Gupca St., company number 20127791, and consequently of indirect control over Private health institution Goodwill Apoteka, with registered seat in Subotica at the address 10 Matka Vukotića St., company number 08900744, by acquiring 100% of shares.

**II IT IS ESTABLISHED** that company Benu d.o.o. Beograd, with registered seat in Belgrade at the address 239 Kumodraška St., positively executed its payment commitment as compensation for issuing this decision on November 9, 2017, by paying the amount of RSD 2,971,797.50 (in words: two million, nine hundred seventy-one thousand, seven hundred ninety-seven and 50/100 dinars) to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents appropriate dinar-currency value of EUR 25,000.00 (in words: twenty-five thousand euro) calculated at the middle exchange rate of the National Bank of Serbia on the day of payment.
