Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-757/2017-1 of December 8, 2017, submitted by company Messer Belgium N.V., with registered seat at the address Haven 1053, Nieuwe Weg 1, 2070 Zwijndrecht, Belgium, company number 0402166453, via attorney at law Nikola B. Poznanović from the Law Firm „Janković Popović Mitić“, 16a Palmotićeve St., Belgrade, on December 22, 2017, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of control on the part of company Messer Belgium N.V., with registered seat at the address Haven 1053, Nieuwe Weg 1, 2070 Zwijndrecht, Belgium, company number 0402166453, and its subsidiary company Messer Romania Gaz Srl, with registered seat at the address Delea Veche 24, Corp A, third floor, 024102 Bucharest, Romania, registered in the National Trade Register Office in Bucharest under number J 40/4298/1998, company number 10547308, over company Buse Gaz Srl, with registered seat at the address Drumul Intre Tarlale 102-112, sector 3, Bucharest, Romania, registered in the National Trade Register Office in Bucharest under number J 40/24507/1994, company number 6863140, by acquiring 100% of shares.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the Party, company Messer Belgium N.V., with registered seat at the address Haven 1053, Nieuwe Weg 1, 2070 Zwijndrecht, Belgium, executed payment in the amount of EUR 25,000.00 (in words: twenty-five thousand and 00/100 euro) on December 11, 2017 to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents appropriate stipulated amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
