Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13) and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/2011), deciding under the notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-759/2017-1 of December 11, 2017, submitted by company „JT International Holding B.V.“, with registered seat at the address Bella Donna 4, 1181RM, Amstelveen, the Netherlands, via attorney at law Danijel Stevanović from the Law Office „Moravčević Vojnović & Partneri“ from Belgrade, 15 Dobračina St., on December 20, 2017, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of indirect control on the part of company “JT International Holding B.V.“, with registered seat at the address Bella Donna 4, 1181RM, Amstelveen, the Netherlands, registered in the Business Register maintained by the Netherlands Chamber of Commerce under company number 32073749, via its wholly owned subsidiary company „JT International NTE (Ethiopia) Holding B.V.“, with registered seat at the address Bella Donna 4, 1181 RM Amstelveen, the Netherlands, registered in the Business Register maintained by the Netherlands Chamber of Commerce under company number 66298563, over company „National Tobacco Enterprise (Ethiopia) Share Company“, with registered seat at the address Roosevelt Street 722, P.O. Box 522, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, company registration number 0000025381, by acquiring shares.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the Party executed payment in the amount of RSD 2,990,857.50 (in words: two million, nine hundred ninety thousand, eight hundred fifty-seven and 50/100 dinars) on December 12, 2017 to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents stipulated amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
