## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of direct control on the part of company Knauf International GmbH, with registered seat at the address Am Bahnhof 7, 97346 Iphofen, FR Germany, company number HRB 5956, over business operations consisting of the production and sale of modular suspended ceilings owned by company Armstrong World Industries, with registered seat at the address 2500 Columbia Avenue, Lancaster, Pennsylvania, company number 06391386, which also include operations of its controlled companies in Europe, Africa, as well as in the Middle East and Pacific regions.

**II IT IS ESTABLISHED** that the Party, company Knauf International GmbH, with registered seat at the address Am Bahnhof 7, 97346 Iphofen, FR Germany, company number HRB 5956, executed payment in the amount of EUR 25,000.00 (in words: twenty-five thousand euro) on January 22, 2018 to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents appropriate amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
