Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-215/2018-1 of February 20, 2018 submitted by company Neregelia Trading Limited, with registered seat at the address Grevi Digeni Panayides Building, 2nd floor, Office #3, 3030 Limassol, Cyprus, company number HE 95511, via attorney at law Dragan Gajin from the Law Office Doklestić & Partneri, 203 Oslobođenja Blvd., Belgrade, on March 1, 2018, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of direct individual control on the part of company Neregelia Trading Limited, with registered seat at the address Grevi Digeni Panayides Building, 2nd floor, Office #3, 3030 Limassol, Cyprus, company number HE 95511, over company Nelo Energy d.o.o. Dobanovci, with registered seat at the address 206 Maršala Tita St., Dobanovci, Republic of Serbia, company number 20653787, created by acquiring 50% of shares and changing the joint into individual control.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the Party, company Neregelia Trading Limited, with registered seat at the address Grevi Digeni Panayides Building, 2nd floor, Office #3, 3030 Limassol, Cyprus, company number HE 95511, executed payment in the amount of RSD 2,950,320.00 (in words: two million, nine hundred fifty thousand, three hundred twenty dinars) on February 23, 2018 to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents stipulated amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
