Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the notification on concentration entered under number 6/0-02-792/2017-1 of December 21, 2017, submitted by company Solford Trading Limited, with registered seat at the address Griva Digeni kai Anastasiou Sioukri, 2 Pamelva Court, 3105 Limassol, Cyprus, via attorney at law Veljko Smiljanić from the Law Firm “Karanović & Nikolić”, 23 Resavska St., Belgrade, on January 18, 2018, member of the Council of the Commission for Protection of Competition acting upon the authority granted by the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition no. 1/0-06-119/2018-2 of January 8, 2017, enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of individual control on the part of company Solford Trading Limited, with registered seat at the address Griva Digeni kai Anastasiou Sioukri, 2 Pamelva Court, 3105 Limassol, Cyprus, company number HE 305830, over the target business operations of „Over-the-top“ media services platform under registered trademark „BHOTT TV“, solely owned by company GROHS H&G d.o.o., with registered seat at the address 18 Radnička St., Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina, company number 65-01-0369-09.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that company Solford Trading Limited executed payment in the amount of EUR 25,000.00 (in words: twenty-five thousand euro) on January 5, 2018 to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents stipulated amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
