Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the notification of concentration entered under number 6/0-02-555/2018-1 of July 20, 2018, submitted by companies Ina-Industrija Nafte d.d., with registered seat at the address 10 Večeslava Holjevca Ave., Zagreb, Croatia, and Prvo Plinarsko Društvo d.o.o., with registered seat at the address 27 A. Stepinca St., Vukovar, Croatia, via procuration holder, attorney at law Milica Boškov from the Law Office NKO Partners from Belgrade, 11 Njegoševa St., on August 1, 2018, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of indirect joint control on the part of companies Ina-Industrija Nafte d.d., with registered seat at the address 10 Večeslava Holjevca Ave., Zagreb, Croatia, company number 080000604, and Prvo Plinarsko Društvo d.o.o., with registered seat at the address 27 A. Stepinca St., Vukovar, Croatia, company number 030070559, via subsidiary company Terra Mineralna Gnojiva d.o.o., with registered seat at the address 41 Savska cesta St., Zagreb, Croatia, company number 081183189, over company Petrokemija d.d., with registered seat at the address 4 Aleja Vukovar St., Kutina, Croatia, company number 080004355, through a share capital increase.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the Party, company Ina-Industrija Nafte d.d., has executed payment in the amount of EUR 25,000.00 (in words: twenty-five thousand euro) on July 30, 2018, to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents a stipulated amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
