Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the notification of concentration entered under number 6/0-02-605/2018-1 of August 17, 2018, submitted by company Generali Finance Sp. z o.o., with registered seat at the address Postępu 15B, 02-676 Warsaw, Poland, via procuration holder, attorney at law Raško Radovanović from the Law Office of Petrikić & Partners, 73 Krunska St., Belgrade, on September 12, 2018, President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of indirect control on the part of company Assicurazioni Generali S.p.A., with registered seat at the address Piazza Duca degli Abruzzi 2 CAP 34132, Trieste, Italy, company number 00079760328, via its subsidiary company Generali Finance Sp. z o.o., with registered seat at the address Postępu 15B, 02-676 Warsaw, Poland, registered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register of Poland under company number 0000166290, over company Bezpieczny.pl Sp. z o.o., with registered seat at the address Goplanska 56, 80-178 Gdansk, Poland, registered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register of Poland under company number 0000549919, executed by acquiring shares.

II IT IS ESTABLISHED that the Party has executed payment in the amount of RSD 2,950,507.50 (in words: two million, nine hundred fifty thousand, five hundred seven and 50/100 dinars) on August 20, 2018, to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents a stipulated amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
