Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the notification of concentration entered under number 6/0-02-698/2018-1, submitted by companies Daimler AG, with registered seat at the address Mercedesstraße 137, 70327 Stuttgart, FR Germany, and Volkswagen Financial Services AG, with registered seat at the address Gifhorner Straße 57, 38112 Braunschweig, FR Germany, represented by procurator holder, attorney at law Danijel Stevanović from Belgrade, 15 Dobračina St., on November 2, 2018, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by the acquisition of joint indirect control on the part of companies Daimler AG, with registered seat at the address Mercedesstraße 137, 70327 Stuttgart, FR Germany, company number HRB 19360, and Volkswagen Financial Services AG, with registered seat at the address Gifhorner Straße 57, 38112 Braunschweig, FR Germany, company number HRB 3790, over company Mobility Trader Holding GmbH, with registered seat at the address Müllerstraße 153, 13353 Berlin, FR Germany, company number HRB 192278, currently fully owned by company Volkswagen Financial Services AG, which is established by purchasing 20% shares in company Mobility Trader Holding GmbH on the part of company Daimler AG.

**II IT IS ESTABLISHED** that the Parties, companies Daimler AG and Volkswagen Financial Services AG, both with registered seats in FR Germany, have fully complied with their legal obligations to compensate for the issuance of this decision on October 9, 2018, by paying the amount of RSD 2,966,580.00 (in words: two million, nine hundred sixty-six thousand, five hundred eighty dinars) to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition.
