Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the notification of concentration entered under number 6/0-02-896/2018-1 of December 19, 2018, submitted by the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development, with registered seat at the address One Exchange Square, London EC2A 2JN, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, via procurator holder, attorney at law Ana Banićijević, 6 Mihajla Pupina Blvd., Belgrade, on December 26, 2018, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by acquisition of joint control on the part of the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development, with registered seat at the address One Exchange Square, London EC2A 2JN, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, over company PREDUZEĆE ZA PROIZVODNJU I PROMET NAMEŠTAJA FORMA IDEALE DOO, with registered seat at the address 13 Skladišni centar St., Kragujevac, company number 17546830, by purchasing shares, which will be executed with other shareholders, natural persons Vladimir Lazarević, 7 Hasana Brkića St., Kragujevac, [...], and Nikola Lazarević, 7 Hasana Brkića St., Kragujevac, [...].

**II IT IS ESTABLISHED** that the Party, the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development, has executed payment in the amount of RSD 2,956,772.50 (in words: two million, nine hundred fifty-six thousand, seven hundred seventy-two and 50/100 dinars) on December 21, 2018, to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents a stipulated amount of the fee as compensation for issuing decision on approval of concentration in summary procedure.
