Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), deciding under the merger notification entered under number 6/0-02-324/2019-1 of March 11, 2019, submitted by companies Eurobank Ergasias S.A., with registered seat at the address 8 Othonos Street, 10557 Athens, Greece, and Grivalia Properties REIC, with registered seat at the address 117 Kifissias Avenue & Agiou Konstantinou Maroussi, 15124 Athens, Greece, via procuration holder, attorney at law Danijel Stevanović from the Law Office “Moravčević, Vojnović i Partneri”, 15 Dobračina St., Belgrade, on April 1, 2019, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED** created by the merger of companies Eurobank Ergasias S.A., with registered seat at the address 8 Othonos Street, 10557 Athens, Greece, company number 000223001000, and Grivalia Properties REIC, with registered seat at the address 117 Kifissias Avenue & Agiou Konstantinou Maroussi, 15124 Athens, Greece, company number 000239101000, whereas company Grivalia Properties REIC will be merged into company Eurobank Ergasias S.A. which will continue to operate.

**II IT IS ESTABLISHED** that the parties, companies Eurobank Ergasias S.A. and Grivalia Properties REIC, both with registered seats in Greece, have fully complied with their legal obligation to compensate for the issuance of this decision on March 25, 2019, by paying the amount of RSD 2,950,750.00 (in words: two million nine hundred fifty thousand seven hundred fifty dinars) into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition.
