Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), on receipt of the merger notification No. 6/0-02-669/2019-1 of July 26, 2019, submitted by company Petrol društvo za trgovinu naftom i naftnim derivatima d.o.o. Beograd (Rakovica), with registered seat at the address 12v Patrijarha Dimitrija St., Belgrade, via procuration holder, attorney at law Igor Isailović from Belgrade, 16 Balkanska St., on August 8, 2019, a member of the Council of the Commission for Protection of Competition acting under the authority granted by the Commission President No. 1/0-06-168/2019-2 of January 8, 2019, enacts the following

## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **IS APPROVED**, created by acquisition of direct control on the part of company Petrol društvo za trgovinu naftom i naftnim derivatima d.o.o. Beograd (Rakovica), with registered seat at the address 12v Patrijarha Dimitrija St., Belgrade, company number 17454404, over a petrol station owned by company A.M. INTERGROUP 012 DOO POŽAREVAC, with registered seat at the address 34 Kosovska St., Požarevac, company number 20284013, located in Požarevac, on the right-hand side of M24 Arterial highway, i.e. State road 33 IB-class (new road classification), on cadastral plots 20033, 20039/2 and 20815, all in CM Požarevac, pursuant to the Lease Agreement.

**II IT IS ESTABLISHED** that the party, company Petrol društvo za trgovinu naftom i naftnim derivatima d.o.o.
