Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), on receipt of the merger notification No. 6/0-02-125/2020-1 of January 3, 2020, submitted by company Intesa Sanpaolo Vita S.p.A, with registered office at Corso Inghilterra, 3 10138 Torino, Italy, represented by procurator holder, attorney at law Srđana Petronijević, 15 Dobračina St., Belgrade, on February 22. January 2020, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of direct individual control on the part of company Intesa Sanpaolo Vita S.p.A, with registered office at Corso Inghilterra, 3 10138 Torino, Italy, company number 02505650370, over company RBM Assicurazione Salute S.p.A., with registered office at Via Enrico Forlanini, 24 31022 Borgo Verde, Preganziol (TV), Italy, company number 05796440963, and its subsidiary companies, by purchasing shares.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the party had made payment in the amount of EUR 24,921.00 (in words: twenty-four thousand nine hundred twenty-one euro) on January 9, 2019, and RSD 9,287.87 (in words: nine thousand two hundred eighty-seven and 87/100 dinars) on January 10, 2019, into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which in total represent the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in summary procedure.
