## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of individual control on the part of company Metinvest B.V., with registered office at Nassaulaan 2A, 2514 JS's-Gravenhage, the Netherlands, company number 24321697, over the entire assets of company ISD Huta Częstochowa sp. Z o.o. w upadłości, with registered office at Kucelińska 22, 42-207 Cęstohova, Poland, company number 0000136890, comprising of a steel plant, by purchasing said assets in the insolvency proceedings.

**II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED** that the notifying party, company Metinvest B.V., had made payment in the amount of XXX (XXX) euro on April 16, 2020, into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in summary procedure.
