Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), on receipt of the merger notification No. 6/0-02-275/2020-1 of February 6, 2020, filed by company Farmalogist Holding d.o.o., with registered office at 25-27 Bulevar Vojvode Mišića Blvd., Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, via procurator holder Dragan Gajin, an attorney at law from the Law Office of Doklešić Repić & Gajin, 203 Bulevar Oslobođenja Blvd., Belgrade, on June 3, 2020, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of direct individual control on the part of company Farmalogist Holding d.o.o., company number 20306327, with registered office at 25-27 Bulevar Vojvode Mišića Blvd., Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, over companies Septima DOOEL Skopje, company number 5369908, with registered office at 9 Hristo Tatarčev 13 St., Skopje - Kisela Voda, North Macedonia, and Pontera Pharma Solutions d.o.o. Podgorica, company number 5-0796869/004, with registered office at bb Cijevna St., Podgorica, Montenegro, by purchasing shares.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the notifying party, company Farmalogist Holding d.o.o., had made payment in the amount of XXX (XXX) dinars on February 7, 2020, into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents a dinar-currency equivalent value of the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in summary procedure, calculated at the middle exchange rate of the National Bank of Serbia on the day of payment.
