Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), in proceedings instituted on receipt of the merger notification No. 6/0-02-758/2019-1 of September 9, 2019, filed by Zdravstvena ustanova Apoteka BENU Beograd, with registered office at 4 Kosovska St., Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, via legal representative Dejan Aleksov, CEO, on October 2, 2019, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of direct individual control on the part of Zdravstvena ustanova Apoteka BENU Beograd, with registered office at 4 Kosovska St., Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, company number 17571206, over the business assets and operations of Apoteka Una Kragujevac, operating in the legal form of entrepreneurial business managed by Gorica Čalasan, with registered office at 7 Crvenog krsta St., Kragujevac, Republic of Serbia, company number 55128740, which represents an independent legal entity, pursuant to the Agreement on Purchase and Sale of Business Assets.

**II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED** that the notifying party, Zdravstvena ustanova Apoteka BENU Beograd, had made payment in the amount of XXX on September 9, 2019, into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents a dinar-currency equivalent value of the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in summary procedure, calculated at the middle exchange rate of the National Bank of Serbia on the day of payment.
