Pursuant to Article 22(2) and Article 65(3) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/7) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), in proceedings instituted on receipt of a merger notification filed by company Privredno društvo za proizvodnju, promet i usluge Agromarket doo Kragujevac, with registered office at 235/2 Kraljevačkog bataljona St., Kragujevac, Republic of Serbia, via legal representative, Dušan Mojsilović, CEO, and resumed as a merger investigation procedure *ex officio*, at the 19<sup>th</sup> Session held on June 19, 2020, the Council of the Commission for Protection of Competition adopts the following

## **DECISION**

**I** Concentration of undertakings in investigation procedure *ex officio* **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of direct individual control on the part of company Privredno društvo za proizvodnju, promet i usluge Agromarket doo Kragujevac, with registered office at 235/2 Kraljevačkog bataljona St., Kragujevac, Republic of Serbia, company number 07593252, over company Akcionarsko društvo Galenika fitofarmacija za proizvodnju hemikalija za poljoprivredu Beograd (Zemun), with registered office at bb Batajnički drum St., Zemun, Republic of Serbia, company number 07725531, and its subsidiary companies, by purchasing shares.

**II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED** that company Agromarket doo Kragujevac had made payment in the amount of XXX dinars on March 17, 2020 into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in investigation procedure.
