Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), in proceedings instituted on receipt of the merger notification No. 6/0-02-371/2020-1 of March 24, 2020, filed by company OMV Aktiengesellschaft, with registered office at Trabrennstraße 6-8, A-1020 Vienna, Austria, via procurator holder Srđana Petronijević, an attorney at law from the Law Office “Moravčević, Vojnović i Partneri” from Belgrade, 6-8 Vojvode Bojovića Blvd., on June 11, 2020, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition adopts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of indirect individual control on the part of company OMV Aktiengesellschaft, with registered office at Trabrennstraße 6-8, A-1020 Vienna, Austria, company registration number FN 93363z, via its wholly owned subsidiary company OMV Refining & Marketing GmbH, with registered office at Trabrennstraße 6-8, A-1020 Vienna, Austria, company registration number FN 185462p, over company Borealis AG, with registered office at Wagramerstraße 17–19, A-1220 Vienna, Austria, company registration number FN 269858a, and its subsidiaries, by purchasing shares.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the notifying party, OMV Aktiengesellschaft, had made payment in the amount of XXX euro on June 2, 2020 into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in summary procedure.
