DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of direct individual control on the part of company Porsche Informatik Gesellschaft m.b.H., with registered office at Louise-Piëch-Straße 9, 5020 Salzburg, Austria, company registration number FN 72830 d, over company DASOF trgovsko in storitveno podjetje, d.o.o., with registered office at 6 Ukmarjeva ulica St., 1000 Ljubljana, Slovenia, company registration number 5670519000, by purchasing shares.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the notifying party had made payment in the amount of XXX euros on January 20, 2020, and the amount of XXX euros on January 24, 2020, into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which in total represents the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in summary procedure.
