Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), in proceedings instituted on receipt of the Merger notification No. 6/0-02-253/2020 of February 3, 2020 filed by company Apotekarska ustanova „Dr. Max” Beograd, with registered office at 25 Miloša Pocerca St., Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, via procuration holder Anđela Mirković and other attorneys at law from the Law Office NKO Partners oad Beograd, 11 Njegoševa St., on March 13, 2020, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of direct individual control on the part of company Apotekarska ustanova „Dr. Max” Beograd, with registered office at 25 Miloša Pocerca St., Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, company number 17151088, over a part of business operations of company Zdravstvena ustanova apoteka Kruševac, with registered office at 34 Ćirila i Metodija St., Kruševac, Republic of Serbia, company number 17385704, relating to the running of pharmaceutical healthcare operations at the primary level in the territory of Rasina District, pursuant to the Decision on the selection of the most advantageous bidder No. 515-2/2020 of January 17, 2020.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the notifying party, company Apotekarska ustanova “Dr. Max” Beograd, had made payment in the amount of XXX dinars on March 10, 2020 into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in summary procedure.
