Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), in proceedings instituted on receipt of the merger notification No. 6/0-02-366/2020-1 of March 23, 2020, filed by company Messer Group GmbH, with registered office at Messer-Platz 1, 60598 Bad Soden, Germany, represented by procurator holder, attorney at law Nikola B. Poznanović, with registered office at 6 Vladimira Popovića St., Belgrade, on April 16, 2020, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of indirect individual control on the part of company Messer Group GmbH, with registered office at Messer-Platz 1, 60598 Bad Soden, Germany, company number HRB 73307, over company AIR LIQUIDE CZ, s.r.o., with registered office at Jinonicka 804/80, PSČ 15000, Prague 5, Czechia, company number 264 61 609, and company AIR LIQUIDE SLOVAKIA, s.r.o., with registered office at Piešť'anska 8188/3, Trnava 917 01, Slovakia, company number 35 788 283, by purchasing shares.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the notifying party had made payment in the amount of XXX euros on March 25, 2020, into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in summary procedure.
