Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), in proceedings instituted on receipt of the Merger notification No. 6/0-02-593/2020-1 of September 9, 2020 filed by company Schneider Electric SE, with registered office at 35 rue Joseph Monier, 92500 Rueil Malmaison Cedex, France, via procuration holder, attorney at law Maja Stanković from the Law Office Wolf Theiss, BC Ušće, 6 Mihajla Pupina Blvd., New Belgrade, on October 5, 2020, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of control on the part of company Schneider Electric SE, with registered office at 35 rue Joseph Monier, 92500 Rueil Malmaison Cedex, France, company number 542 048 574 R.C.S., via its affiliated company AVEVA Group PLC, with registered office at High Cross, Madingley Road, Cambridge, United Kingdom, company number 2937296, over company OSISOFT LLC, with registered office at San Leandro Tech Campus, 1600 Alvarado Street, CA 94577 San Leandro, United States of America, company number 4718889, by purchasing shares and business units.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that company AVEVA Group PLC with registered office in the United States of America had made payment in the amount of XXX on September 14, 2020 into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in summary procedure.
