Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13) and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), in proceedings instituted on receipt of the Merger notification No. 6/0-02-591/2020-1 of September 9, 2020 filed by company MYLAN N.V., with corporate headquarters at Building 4, Trident Place, Mosquito Way, Hatfield, Hertfordshire, AL10 9UL, England, Great Britain, via procurator holder Danijel Stevanović and other attorneys at law from the Law Office of Moravčević, Vojnović i Partneri from Belgrade, 6-8 Vojvode Bojovića Blvd., on September 24, 2020, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of individual control on the part of company MYLAN N.V., with corporate headquarters at Building 4, Trident Place, Mosquito Way, Hatfield, Hertfordshire, AL10 9UL, England, Great Britain, incorporated in the Netherlands under company number 61036137, over a part of assets owned by company ASPEN GLOBAL INCORPORATED, with registered seat in Mauritius, and its affiliated companies, which includes the operations of this company concerning four antithrombotic products in Europe and which may represent an independent business entity.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the notifying party, company MYLAN N.V., had made payment in the amount of XXX dinars on September 16, 2020 into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in summary procedure, calculated at the middle exchange rate of the National Bank of Serbia on the day of payment.
