DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of individual control on the part of company Symrise AG, with registered office at Mühlenfeldstr 1, 37603 Holzminden, Federal Republic of Germany, company number HRB 200436, over operations of company Sensient Technologies Corporation, with registered office at 777 East Wisconsin Avenue, Milwaukee, WI 53202-5304 United States of America, company registration number 39-0561070, relating to fragrance and aroma chemicals business.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the notifying party, company Symrise AG, had made payment in the amount of XXX on December 11, 2020 into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which represents the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in summary procedure.
