Pursuant to Article 37(2) and Article 65(5) of the Law on Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 51/09 and 95/13) and Article 2(1/6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (Official Gazette of the RS 49/11), in proceedings instituted on receipt of the Merger notification No. 6/0-02-200/2021-1 of January 4, 2021 filed by company Intesa Sanpaolo S.p.A., with registered office at Piazza San Carlo 156, Torino, Italy, via procuration holder, attorney at law Srđana Petronijević from Belgrade, 6-8 Vojvode Bojovića Blvd., on February 3, 2021, the President of the Commission for Protection of Competition enacts the following

DECISION

I Concentration of undertakings in summary procedure **SHALL BE APPROVED**, created by acquisition of individual control on the part of company Intesa Sanpaolo S.p.A., with registered office at Piazza San Carlo 156, Torino, Italy, company registration number 00799960158, over company Lombarda Vita S.p.A., with registered office at Corso Martiri della Liberta 13, Brescia, Italy, company registration number 03571340177, by way of purchase of shares.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the notifying party, company Intesa Sanpaolo S.p.A., had made payment in the amount of XXX euro on January 14, 2021 and XXX dinars on January 18, 2021 into the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, which in total represents the fee charged for issuing a merger clearance decision in summary procedure.
