President of the Commission for Protection of Competition, pursuant to Article 37 paragraph 2 and Article 65 paragraph 5 of the Law on Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia”, number 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2 paragraph 1 item 6 of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, No. 49/11), in deciding upon notification on concentration number 6/0-02-729/2021-1, submitted on October 27, 2021, by joint-stock company Banka poštanska štedionica Belgrade, seated at 3 Kraljice Marije, Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, through the holder of the Power of Attorney lawyer Aleksandar Preradović, 23 Kneza Miloša Street, Belgrade, on November 1, 2021, adopts the following

DECISION

I APPROVING, in summary procedure, market participants concentration from acquisition of individual control by the joint-stock company Banka poštanska štedionica Belgrade, seated at 3 Kraljice Marije Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, reg.no. 07004893 over the joint-stock company Komercijalna banka Banja Luka, seated at 69 Jevrejska Street, Banja Luka, Bosnia and Herzegovina, reg.no. 3-30-00, through the purchase of 100% of shares.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the notifying party paid the amount of RSD XXX, on October 29, 2021 to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, representing regulated amount for the issuance of decision on concentration approval in summary procedure.
