President of the Commission for Protection of Competition, pursuant to Article 37 paragraph 2 and Article 65 paragraph 5 of the Law on Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia”, number 51/09 and 95/13) and Article 2 paragraph 1 item 6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, No. 49/11), in deciding on the concentration notification number 6/0-02-632/2021-1, submitted on September 2, 2021 by SAT-TRAKT DOO, with seat at 111 Maršala Tita Street, Bačka Topola, through the holder of the Power of Attorney lawyer Blagoje Kondić, 6/7 Kneza Miloša Street, Belgrade, on December 14, 2021, adopts the following

DECISION

I APPROVING in summary procedure, the concentration of market participants from obtaining individual control by SAT-TRAKT DOO, seated at 111 Maršala Tita Street, Bačka Topola, reg. no. 08551375, over the company IPON BEZBEDNOST DOO, seated at 33 Svetozara Đorovića Street, Novi Sad, reg. no.21055506, by purchase of shares.

II THE OBLIGATION of the applicant, the company SAT-TRAKT DOO, **IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED**, to pay the fee for issuing the document approving the concentration in the total amount of XXX EUR, in dinar counter value at the middle exchange rate of the National Bank of Serbia, valid on the date of the return of the paid dinar funds, whereby the Commission for the Protection of Competition **IS BOUND** to return the difference up to the amount paid of XXX RSD, and which have been paid to the name of the fee for issuing the decision on concentration approval.
