President of the Commission for Protection of Competition, pursuant to Article 37 paragraph 2 and Article 65 paragraph 5 of the Law on Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia”, number 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2 paragraph 1 item 6 of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, No. 49/11), in deciding upon notification of concentration number 6/0-02-274/2022-1, submitted on February 3, 2022 by Pharmaceutical institution “Vegafarma”, seated at 16 Železnička Street, Valjevo, Republic of Serbia, through its holder of power of attorney Bojan Stanivuk, from Stanivuk&Manasijevski a.o.d. Belgrade law office, 24/3 Prote Mateje Street, on April 4, 2022, adopts the following

DECISION

I APPROVING in summary procedure, market participants concentration from acquisition of individual control by the Pharmaceutical institution “Vegafarma”, seated at 16 Železnička Street, Valjevo, Republic of Serbia, reg.no.17650807 over the Pharmaceutical institution „Hygieia“, seated at 101 Daničićeva Street, Kragujevac, Republic of Serbia, reg.no. 17823868 , through purchase of 100% of shares.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the notifying party, Pharmaceutical institution “Vegafarma”, paid the amount of XXX dinars, on March 24, 2022 to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, representing appropriate regulated amount for the issuance of decision on concentration approval in summary procedure.
