President of the Commission for Protection of Competition, pursuant to Article 37 paragraph 2 and Article 65 paragraph 5 of the Law on Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia”, number 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2 paragraph 1 item 6 of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, No. 49/11), in deciding on the notification of concentration number 6/0-02-494/2021-1, submitted on June 11, 2021 by Diplomatic Logistic Centar d.o.o, with seat at Park Ferenc Rajhla 13, Subotica, through holder of the Power of Attorney lawyer Srđana Petronijević, from Law Office Moravčević Vojnović and Partners AOD, 6-8 Bulevar vojvode Bojovića Street, Belgrade, on August 20, 2021 adopts the following

DECISION

I APPROVING in summary procedure, the concentration of market participants resulting from acquisition of individual control by Diplomatic Logistic Centar d.o.o, with seat at Park Ferenc Rajhla 13, Subotica registration number 21650277, over Pevec d.o.o. with seat at 81 Pančevački put, Belgrade, registration number 20052198, which may represent an independent business entity, by purchase of facility - the production-commercial complex “Pevec”, located at the address 81 Pančevački put, Belgrade.

IIIT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the notifying party, Diplomatic Logistic Centar d.o.o, paid the amount of RSD XXX, on July 20, 2021 to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, representing appropriate regulated amount for the issuance of decision on concentration approval in summary procedure according to the middle exchange rate of the National Bank of Serbia on payment date.
