DECISION

I APPROVING in summary procedure, the concentration of market participants from obtaining individual control by A1 Bulgaria EAD, seated at Кукуш no. 1, Илинден Дистрикт, 1309 Sofia, Bulgaria, reg. no. 131468980, over the company Stemo o.o.d. seated at Николаевска 48, Габрово, Bulgaria, reg. no. 817080126, by purchase of 100% of shares.
