President of the Commission for Protection of Competition, pursuant to Article 37 paragraph 2 and Article 65 paragraph 5 of the Law on Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia”, number 51/09 and 95/13), and Article 2 paragraph 1 item 6 of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, No. 49/11), in deciding on the notification of concentration number 6/0-02-790/2022-1, submitted on November 25, 2022 by the company ZF Friedrichshafen AG, with headquarters at Löwentaler Straße 20, Friedrichshafen, Germany, through attorney Srđana Petronijević from law office Moravčević Vojnović and partners AOD Belgrade, Bulevar vojvode Bojovića 6-8, Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, on December 15, 2022, adopts the following

DECISION

I APPROVING in summary procedure, concentration of market participants from obtaining individual control by the company ZF Friedrichshafen AG, with registered office at Löwentaler Straße 20, Friedrichshafen, Germany, ID number HRB 630206, over Intellic Germany GmbH, with registered office at Innungsstraße 40, Berlin, Germany, ID number HRB 144099 B, by purchasing 100% of the shares and over a part of the company Intellic GmbH Austria, with headquarters at Karnter Strasse 518/4, 8054 Sellersberg, Austria, registration number FN 291914k, which can represent an independent business entity, by purchasing all movable fixed and current assets and the database of customers and suppliers of this company.

II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED that the notifying party, ZF Friedrichshafen AG, paid the amount of XXX RSD, on December 2, 2022 to the account of the Commission for Protection of Competition, representing the prescribed amount for the issuance of decision on concentration approval in summary procedure.
