I APPROVING, in summary procedure, market participants concentration from acquisition of individual control by the company Robert Bosch GmbH, with headquarters at Robert-Bosch-Platz 1, Gerlingen-Schillerhöhe, Germany, registration number HRB 14000, over the companies PalAmerican Technologies Inc. with headquarters at 12 West 21st Street, New York, United States of America, registration number 604 126 147, and Paladin Technologies Inc. with its registered office at 1350-355 Burrad Street, Vancouver, Canada, by purchasing 100% of the shares
