President of the Commission for Protection of Competition, pursuant to Article 37 paragraph 2 and Article 65 paragraph 5 of the Law on Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia”, number 51/09 and 95/13) and Article 2 paragraph 1 item 6) of the Tariff on the level of compensations for activities within the competence of the Commission for Protection of Competition (“Official Gazette of the RS”, No. 49/11), in deciding on the notification of concentration No. 6/0-02-672/2024-1, submitted on 27 May 2024 by the undertakings Premijus d.o.o. Beograd-Zemun, with registered office at Stanka Tišme 31Đ, Belgrade, and Difol d.o.o. Beograd-Zemun, with registered office at Svetozara Papića 21/10, Belgrade, through their authorized representative, attorney Blagoja Kondić, with address at Kapetana Popovića 5/c, Belgrade, on 7 August 2024, issues the following decision:

**DECISION**

**I APPROVING** under the summary procedure, the concentration of market participants resulting from the acquisition of joint control by the undertakings Premijus d.o.o. Beograd-Zemun, with registered office at Stanka Tišme 31Đ, Belgrade, registration number 21309192, and Difol d.o.o. Beograd-Zemun, with registered office at Svetozara Papića 21/10, Belgrade, registration number 17347195, over the undertaking Demetra RB d.o.o. Beograd, with registered office at Zarija Vujoševića 80, Belgrade, registration number 06517293, through the joint acquisition of 50% of its shares, to be carried out together with a third member of this undertaking, the natural person Radenko Bakoč.

**II IT SHALL BE ESTABLISHED** that the notifying party paid the amount of RSD XXX, on June 13, 2024 and the amount of RSD XXX on August 6, 2024 representing thus the regulated amount for the issuance of decision on concentration approval in summary procedure.
